
Marek Malysa

WHAT I AM GOING TO OFFER TO WBF

In WBF statutes art. 5 says that very first purpose for WBF is to **promote** the game of bridge.

Being Chairman of the WBF Bridge & Science Committee as well as an active researcher I would like to support WBF with scientific facts showing advantages our game gives to people, from youngsters to elderly. Scientific proofs will most probably make the way to potential sponsors much easier and will give to all kind of media a chance to present profits coming from playing contract bridge.

Our Polish project "Bridge to Success", when implemented in all countries, will be addressed to our "Blackhole" (25-55 years old) and we hope that it will encourage more people to bridge as an attractive form of spending free time.

My program "BRIDGE 60+", presented during WBF Seminars to 3 Zones, addressed to elderly, offers a way out of loneliness and, what is probably more important, our work may help in the flight to slow or even prevent them from dementia (Alzheimer Disease). All I want to do is to make it working in most of NBOs. It is, by the way, the easiest way to get more members. Taking into account that societies become older and older in many countries and a social impact of this phenomenon is of critical importance for our future our work can help many people enjoy better and healthier old age. It's of utmost importance for the WBF Executive Committee to be part of this work for which I can take full responsibility.
